Water Man David Ross Eulogy:

Water Man David Ross died recently. He once gave me a tarp when I was on the sidewalk in the rain. Seth Combs wrote a nice Obituary in San Diego CityBeat, April 11, 2018, <http://sdcitybeat.com/news-and-opinion/from-the-editor/a-legacy-we-can-all-believe-in/>

David Ross was reclusive, with few knowing him closely. He often conducted funeral wakes and semi-religious services for the many of the homeless who died of either Direct or Indirect Suicides. Over 100 persons per year in San Diego gave up hope because they had no food, no toilets, no showers, no laundromat, no transportation, no job, no address, no bed, and no protection from the sun-wind-rain-cold-heat. And, no one would give them a job that paid enough money to afford rent. **David Ross was our minister, more than anything else, but never tried to hypnotize us into believing in the (Fake) Jesus Christ, nor the (Fake) Bible, either.** His mission was more like the Real Jesus, to help end suffering. Dave taught lessons that he learned in life, some of them practical (common sense) and others economic. He never got his childhood dream of owning a car dealership, but he didn't know the process of business ownership is rigged. He had family ties to the Italian Mafia, but never knew they were his only hope of really becoming a car dealer. He did work as a high-end new car salesman, including for Mercedes.

The water he distributed to the homeless was mostly paid for out of his Social Security check and retirement pension money, and he knew from a Psychologist (me) that water and being hydrated causes far less aggression, fighting, and violence than being thirsty does. Water is a psychological factor in human mood. He was a big fan of the Alpha Project, back when they were more humane than now, and he personally volunteered in the kitchen at Father Joe's Villages for years. He quit Father Joe's because it had become too computerized, where everybody was a number in a computer file, instead of someone to be known personally. That upset him, a Humanist.

I promised the Underground News Agency (not its real name) that I would not make public (until after the death of Ross) that it was the City-County Gnosis-Cabal-Guild (secret conspiracy) group that arranged for Ross to be beaten up many times. That's because he would be badly hurt if he knew. They beat me up several times, too, for my homeless advocacy, nearly killing me twice, but my being a media figure, my "elves" (Investigative Journalists) always told me

every detail, sometimes even in advance. A newspaper is an intelligence agency and an underground newspaper doubly so. If it weren't for me, people wouldn't know about the City-County Gnosis Group (same people) intentionally spreading the Hepatitis A virus to the homeless, in order to make it a homeless issue instead of a tourism one. I still hold hundreds of worse secrets, but I am not trying to tear down San Diego, nor am I threatening any negative action such as exposing the truth on unrelated issues. My work has only to do with the poor and homeless, okay?

Carrying on the work of David Ross, a Convention Center Expansion should contain 100 showers for the homeless, 3,000 storage lockers, 100 apartments for those homeless who work for the conventions, 30 flush toilets, and a laundromat with 20 washers and 30 dryers. **Instead earmarking cash money for homeless programs is not acceptable because the money gets spent so wastefully. We DO NOT support additional money for homeless programs until we first fix the 90% waste that all present programs contain.** We are pouring money into a bucket that has no bottom. All present spending flushes money down the toilet. See also article on homeless storage, in this issue.

The Good Old Boys Election: Real Estate Mafia Threatened

Most Journalists are speculating why Mayor Faulconer suddenly decided to do something about the homeless issue, after years of ignoring it. Sorry, but that's naive. All of the things being done are things that look good on paper but don't count in reality. Not one of them impacts the number of homeless. Sure it looks profound, with huge rubber tents, daily newspaper articles, never-ending meetings, and a forest of editorials cut down to print newspapers, but it's a facade, a veneer, a brass band in the middle of the street that is hiding all the homeless people living on the sidewalk on the other side of the street. It's all about confusing people. It's all about an upcoming election June 5 that will make or break the 100-year-rule of the "Good Old Boys" in San Diego. Up for grabs every 8 to 12 years is the position of Sheriff, the position of District Attorney, plus critical County Board and City Council seats. So, we will have speeches, donations of campaign money, and lots of brass bands obscuring the reality on the homeless issue. **To admit the truth is to admit our politicians failed, and lots of homelessness resulted.** Rather than admit the truth, and responsibility, the number of marching bands went from 5 or 6 to 50 or 60, and if that doesn't take everybody's mind off the homeless issue, maybe 100 more brass bands will. After all, brass bands solve the homeless problem by making people think about something else.

I wrote a lot of famous editorials for a lot of famous editorialists, for many years, so I'm trying to remember one of the Conservative explanations from 35 years ago as to what causes homelessness, from a Conservative perspective. It goes something like, "Homelessness is caused by failing to ignore it." People need help looking the other way, I suppose. Don't look over there, look at the huge parade coming down the street.

I would like to congratulate Tony Atkins, one of the principal designers of San Diego's homeless problem, on being elected President of the State Senate, the first female and the first lesbian to hold that title, but far from the first real estate gangster and redevelopment designer of homeless camps created by Gentrification. Others who created the problem (I am one of their victims) include Todd Gloria, Kevin Faulconer, Ben Hueso, Jerry Sanders, and an All-Star Cast. Creating homelessness is richly rewarding. Oh, sorry to distract your attention from all those big brass bands out there. Yes, I know, there isn't any homeless problem. Oh, look at the clowns! Aren't they funny?

History of San Diego Homeless Storage

San Diego Homeless Storage has always been a contentious issue. Back in the days of Mayor Susan Golding, San Diego's homeless were given designer luggage to carry around all of their possessions, some carrying 20 or 30 suitcases all over The Bottoms, San Diego's Skid Row. Police tried to separate the homeless from their belongings by arresting them for no reason, and taking them, but not their stuff, to the police station. Then, the police called on Clean and Safe, or another earlier agency, to trash and landfill all that some people owned. Many lost the burial urns of their parents or grandparents, medicines, family heirlooms, laptops, photo albums, artwork, book or movie manuscripts, and a lot more that could not be replaced. The District Attorney refused to file felony criminal charges against the City for its thefts.

Things got worse under Mayor Jerry Sanders, Petco Park construction rapidly increasing homeless by the 4,000 low-income apartments and hotel rooms torn down to build it. The watershed moment came when the police partnered with a Baptist missionary church, God's Extended Hands ("God's Extended Finger"), which provided meals for those who were destitute. The rules they made were that in order to eat a meal, homeless had to leave their belongings out on the sidewalk, and then the doors to the church were closed and locked. With the homeless out of access to their possessions, the City loaded everything into garbage trucks, without examining what was being stolen, and compressed it, taking it to a landfill for burial. The ACLU filed suit, not for damages, but to end this sort of brutal practice.

Legal case law has identified various ways to evaluate the possessions of a homeless person, and the most common minimum value given to unknown homeless possessions is about \$8,000 per person. So, the 60 persons who got their stuff stolen lost a total of \$480,000 that day, by legal standards. And, the City theft would be felony theft, not misdemeanor.

The Bottoms was becoming East Village, and Water Man David Ross, who handed out drinking water to the poor, spearheaded the effort for peace and unity. (Note that Ross died recently.) His ACLU lawsuit against the City established that 3 days' notice must be given before an area may be "cleaned" and homeless possessions impounded. In the meantime, Ross was targeted to be independently stabbed, beaten up, and in one case injured by the San Diego Police, a lawsuit they lost, having to pay him damages. His injuries were all a result of the City-County Gnostic Group (Cabal – Guild), but nowhere could that be reported. This happened before the San Diego Homeless News existed. I covered this as a Reporter for Yahoo! News, a division of AT&T, but could not report on the causation of the beatings of Ross, per press agreement that the Conspiracy Groups do not exist. See David Ross Eulogy, this issue.

On the storage issue, the City paid to have a storage facility for the homeless at 9th and E, run by Ross, his husband, and their nonprofit organization, the Isaiah Project. This was the most humane organization in San Diego history, but a tad unusual, being both Gay and Jewish. None of that mattered. (These are the story angles you get in an Underground newspaper that conventional and alternative news reporting leaves out.)

Mayor Jerry Sanders did not want homeless storage to succeed, and shopped for a plan that had failed in dozens of other cities. The idea was to have it all become a huge failure, and so raise the idea that same is a waste of time. Ross accompanied one of the Assistant Police Chiefs to Skid Row in Los Angeles, to learn how to implement this "instant failure" plan. It was very demeaning, requiring a long wait to add or take possessions, and required homeless to store all of their things in a garbage can.

His Isaiah Project Storage Center actually made this plan succeed, because it was so humane. He had signs from Los Angeles, expecting failure here just like there, that read, "No Masturbating While in Line", "No Public Sex", "No Urinating nor Defecation Inside or Outside of the Building", "No Buying, Selling, or Using Dope". The City was not pleased that the plan worked, and looked for another service provider to make it fail. Instead, they found the Girl's Think Tank, a coalition of about 30 high-power female lawyers, to take over. Now re-named Think Dignity, they still successfully operate a homeless storage facility in The Bottoms.

The rules changed, though, in that the agreement to give 3 days' notice before impounding possessions is no longer followed by the City. And, lots of possessions are rounded up and given to Think Dignity to sort out, something not in their contract. Nowadays, the City posts continuous notices everywhere, so it no longer needs to give any advanced notices, because it already has. San Diego has even thrown entire tents into garbage trucks, with people still inside, on many occasions, and got caught by the press doing that in one instance. One touch of the "Compress" button and anyone inside that tent is squished to death. You think they admit murder when they do it? It reduces homelessness whenever homeless get killed by the City, whether via disease, starvation, neglect, police, jail, or any other causes. Usually it's what we call Indirect Suicide, where a person loses interest in being alive, and so does not see a doctor when sick or does not get out of the way of a fast-moving truck. Nearly all homelessness ends this way, and Indirect Suicides do not go on the books as Suicides, but rather accidents or diseases.

The New Storage Facility

Scheduled for 20th and Imperial, just off the trolley tracks, very complicated bids were requested, and bidders had only 4 days to submit same. Think Dignity could not bid, for example. I wrote it before but it was obvious that the City had help with its RFP (Request For Proposals) from one of the bidders that wanted to be the only bidder, and slanted the RFP so that no one else could bid. We now know that the notorious Mental Health Systems "won" that bid, so the City is back to its old tricks of forcing homeless storage to fail. MHS currently uses \$80 million a year in tax money, and is closely linked to some of the absolute WORST mental health funders, such as San Diego County Health and Human Services Dept. **We consider them both completely disorganized, plus incompetent, providing unnecessary treatment to people not mentally ill. People are given drugs to make them mentally ill. That fills up beds, bringing in federal money.** I wrote more than one

scathing editorial on the mental health issue, my Ph.D. being in Psychology, and it resulted in one of the County's affiliated service providers, Promise Behavioral Hospital, being put out of business. They were just the tip of the iceberg, however. You can read the truth about Mental Health on the homeless website mental health page, at NZ9F.com/MH. Be sure to read "Strike Three" which is my account of the horrific abuses within our San Diego County system.

Mental Health Abuses:

When the Soviet Union was going down, their abuses of their Mental Health system became obvious. If you disagreed with the government, you must be mentally ill. The Soviets had a system of electronic mind control, and would send dissidents to certain cities where they had powerful (cellular tower) brainwave transmitters. Ham operators noted that the equipment made sounds on the radio spectrum similar to a woodpecker, and named the brainwashing equipment the "Russian Woodpecker". Some of us trained in both Radio Engineering and Psychology know how this works.

A related abuse is that when a public speaker criticized the government, they were secretly darted with a tranquilizer that made them incoherent. So, the "crime" of mental illness was everywhere.

Move forward into the 1980's and **Psychiatry in the US** got re-routed by President Reagan to be all about control, not help nor personal function. People who had been victimized by the British Bar, US government, and the millions of secret "conspiracy theory" organizations (the Gnosis groups, Cabals, and Guilds) were given drugs by Psychiatrists to make them forget, tranquilizers to make them not care, and hypnosis to try to teach them that they were merely mentally ill, not victims. No one was given a fair settlement, nor any settlement at all. Persons unjustly convicted of crimes and having overwhelming evidence of same were dismissed as mentally ill, and locked up in mental institutions. There was more than one failed attempt to do that to me, including in San Diego.

Three times in my life I was ordered to take a Psychiatric exam, and all three times the team of Psychiatrists insulted the judge, causing courtroom laughter or applause. Some of my lifetime objectives are to never marry, never own real estate, never have children, never believe in God-gods-religion, never serve in the military, in other words the avoidance of the biggest mistakes that people are taught to make. I was also self-employed most of my life, giving me a large amount of control over my life.

I became a victim of the Catholic Church and Christianity in Catholic grade school, which fed me a very large amount of human semen and blood in food, over many years as a young child, causing a mood imbalance. My brain, as a result, produces very little of a chemical transmitter agent called Dopamine. Having too little Dopamine gives a person a poor memory, and a lot of other difficulties, including the fact that I nearly never smile, lifetime.

It took ten years of being abused by the Psychiatric system, plus another ten years of looking for a competent Psychiatrist who also treats poor people, to find treatment to empower me and not just control me. That is the unfortunate circumstance of "public health" Psychiatry. The good news is that I found an excellent Psychiatrist, Dr. Harry Henderson, iii, whose father was also a shrink, and this led to a prescription formula that corrects all of the problems from Religious Abuse, allowing me to function as a Professional. The bad news is that Dr. Henderson had to retire due to old age and poor health. Now it's back to looking for a competent shrink that actually treats poor folks, instead of just hanging out at an office in La Jolla and charging \$200 a half-hour. Lots of great Psychiatrists out there, but they usually won't work for the pennies paid by Public Health and even Medi-Cal. I have now been looking 8 months for a shrink, with no success, because I don't fit the "Programs" and "Systems" in place for mental health. I get told that I am not mentally ill. • Past problems with mental healthcare go sort of like this:

Postscript: In college at the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee, we conducted a Social Psychology experiment. UWM could not do it, because it violated ethics requirements, but Milwaukee Free University, which was secretly a part of both UWM and the US Labor Dept. approved it. The experiment is to send someone to as many Psychiatrists as possible to get a diagnosis of whatever mental illness(es) they have, and then compare the results of the findings of one Psychiatrist against the others. Each and every evaluation came back entirely different.

"I'm sorry Mr. Jones, but you have been found to have nearly every psychiatric disease that ever existed." It isn't quackery, but the process is very editorial to say the least. It is unfortunate, but incorrect diagnostic labels stick. If a person learns their diagnosis, they begin to believe it and start acting how they are "supposed to" act. It is all part of the hypnosis resulting from the Psychiatrist being so powerful Spiritually as opposed to the patient. So, Dr. Sigmund Freud used to say, "The only thing wrong with you is that you think there is something wrong with you. You are perfectly normal." This often caused people to become normal. **About 25% of our homeless are mentally ill, which is the same percentage as the rest of non-homeless society as a whole.** Some Psychologists believe that nearly everyone is mentally ill, and I can see their point. The name of this mental illness that most people have is called "Faith" or "Beliefs".

My diagnosis of me, since I am a Psychologist? Physical, not mental, illness of the brain due to religious abuse (Spirituality), leading to a brain chemical imbalance. Will cause suicide in the long-term if not treated properly. So, how many folks don't get correct Psychiatric care, leading to their eventual suicide? Not many ever get recorded in the legal books as a suicide, because it's all the "Loss of the Will to Live", which is where all homelessness goes. Suicide does tell the whole world to go fuck itself. I have written a lot on it, available at NZ9F.com/Suicide.

Meetings:

The Basic Dignity Coalition of Think Dignity, www.ThinkDignity.Org, met the first Thursday of April, April 5, 6 PM, at the Monicker Warehouse, 705 Sixteenth St., near 16th and G in downtown San Diego. A wedding used the area we usually meet in, so we were upstairs. Sometimes we are on the 17th St. side of the building, too. 8 were present including one homeless (me) and 2 news media (including me). • The San Diego County Employees Charitable Org. donated \$1000 to use to help with **basic public transportation** for poor and/or homeless people, and it will probably go for bus passes. Lyft also donated \$1000 worth of Lyft usage. • The **new Food Café** is being launched by Think Dignity, and it will provide some healthy food choices while on the street. • The **Summer Backpack and tools distribution** (flashlights, tarps, insect repellent, sunscreen, etc.) will probably be in partnership with the Burrito Boys sometime in June, maybe even at the Petco downtown stadium parking lot. • **Bags full of human waste** are being found in Sherman Heights, and some even in Hillcrest and North Park, with no obvious reason why. It is suspected that these are NOT from the homeless. •

A discussion had been held with new **San Diego Police Chief David Nisleit about the criminalization of homelessness**. He said that it is the policy of SDPD to first ask a homeless person (Classification One, on the street in full public display) if they will accept help, first, before issuing a citation. His Assistant Chief Paul Connelly gave us this list of what the police are to do: 1.) First encounter, offer help, merely **documenting that they do not want help** if that is the case. 2.) Second encounter, offer help, **issuing a citation** (ticket) if they do not want services. 3.) Third encounter, offer help, and if they refuse they **may be arrested** for illegal encroachment and their **belongings impounded**. • **END of Meeting.** ♦♦♦♦♦

Editorial Discussion:

Illegal Lodging was taken to court and thrown out, so the City, which never listens to court rulings, is using a different law to harass the homeless. **The courts all ruled that San Diego is 100% at-fault for its homeless problem and has no right to ticket nor harass anyone.** The original Court also ruled that San Diego (City only) homeless have a RIGHT to sleep on City property, including the sidewalks and parks, unmolested by "Outreach" nor the police, from 9 PM to 5:30 AM, seven days a week. This was since modified to exclude Downtown San Diego, and expanded to 6 AM. So, does the City follow court orders?

Other News:

Mum's The Word. On the issue of Racism in San Diego, the City, County, MTS, and the Real Estate Cartel (Mafia) are all keeping silent. Kelly Davis, one of the Founders of CityBeat taught me at the NAEH Convention (National Alliance to End Homelessness) a few years ago, that "You can always tell when you've hit an issue right on the head, because the governments ignore you, and the silence is

deafening." (paraphrased). Davis addressed a Standing-Room-Only crowd of Journalists that day. She is the one who broke the news about the "Sharp Rocks" controversy, about San Diego treating homeless persons as if we are garden pests. We're not human, we're Walking Dead, right? Fits in great with San Diego's "Asshole Mentality" that our city is so famous for. Racism is cut of the same cloth, stupidity. So, how's that for something you don't find in the news media?

May Day is J-Day, written by myself as John Schlitz in the UWM Post, newspaper of the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee in April, 1971, has had all of the archives deleted. At that time, many states sentenced people to fifty years in prison, or more, for tiny marijuana violations. The article promoted a protest of these laws, involving thousands of people smoking marijuana at a public park every year on May First. When UWM took over the newspaper, making it more Conservative, a new radical underground newspaper was created, called "What's Left?" The title was essentially, "What's Left OUT of the UWM Post?" I was Associate Editor and sometimes had to run the presses. The same sort of Political Repression is resurfacing today.

Mexico's Chaparral Border Crossing, called PedWest in the US, now has bus service in Mexico, on the blue-white and yellow-white bus lines, but not all busses go there. There is still usually less waiting time at the old San Ysidro (PedEast) crossing, plus no need to wait for a bus to take you to the trolley.

The RTFH (Regional Task Force on the Homeless) Governing Board is looking for someone to represent the San Diego Homeless. If I volunteered, I would be removed, much like Melanie Stuart was removed from the Grand Jury on the homeless, for knowing too much, years ago. Only stupid people need apply, and there is no salary, either. Sorry, but I am not an idiot.

The Tijuana Rescue Mission, which had no real official name but contained the offices of this newspaper, burned to the ground April 14, 2018, making over 30 people homeless. This delayed publication of this edition more than six days.



The fire got hot enough to melt steel. Two nearby buildings were also set ablaze. The official cause was listed as an accidental cooking fire, but since then there is considerable evidence that drug cartels were involved. This had nothing to do with this newspaper nor San Diego politics.
