# Toilets, Part Two

Dr. John Kitchin for Milwaukee Free University.

We first wrote about the problem of downtown San Diego toilets in 2010, years ago. Since **PAGE TWO** then, there have been many

efforts to address the problem, but instead of getting better, things are far worse. We went from 12 toilets 5 years ago to 6 now, and according to the **Girls Think Tank**, our negotiations team, the **Downtown Partnership (Clean and Safe)** has opposed all past, present, and future toilets downtown, in favor of moving them all to the same spot, (Father Joe's) or outside of Downtown, such as Barrio Logan. In addition, **homeless are being harassed for using the toilets we have.** We have gotten lots of promises the past 5 years, too, but no real action. Even the toilets promised are not enough to replace the ones we have lost in that time, much less make an advancement on the problem. The new toilets are a 1% solution to the problem, at best. (Note that at the MAPSS meeting [Meetings article, below] the Representative of Clean and Safe denied their opposition.)

Girls Think Tank, [www.GirlsThinkTank.Org](http://www.GirlsThinkTank.Org), a group of lawyers, judges, business leaders, concerned citizens, and a handful of very intelligent homeless like myself, has organized pickets, written letters, conducted fund-raisers, held public and private meetings, brainstormed for ideas, and more. Their effectiveness in dealing with the City has become somewhat compromised, however, as they are now receiving City funding to operate the Homeless Storage Program, also important to meeting our needs. My tack is that the tourists are complaining about the lack of toilets even more than we homeless are, and more toilets are needed for the businesspeople, investors, and our ever-expanding elderly population, who need toilets more frequently. A lot of them are here to spend money. I'd rather see Clean and Safe clean poop toilets than poop sidewalks anyday. (See the latest meeting and toilets discussion under "Meetings", below.)

As often stated, toilets are a transportation problem, because there are many toilets out there, but are they were you are when you need them? My suggestion is a toilet bus that can take people to Balboa Park where there are many toilets, plus many spaces to relax on the grass, sleep, throw a softball, or whatever. Buses should also take people back downtown,

as we all have our own neighborhoods that we call "Home", whether or not we actually have a home or apartment there. Be thankful your life is less complicated than ours.

America's Finest City of Sidewalk Shit. And, the City wants to ticket and punish the homeless for this problem that the City created. I call for a Restraining Order which would prohibit San Diego from punishing anyone for the excretion of wastes "as necessary". City's fault.

## Meetings:

**The MAPSS (Metropolitan Association of Providers of Social Services) met** Wed. Apr. 23 with a record-high 42 present. This included many from the now-dissolved ERG (Emergency Resources Group). Normal attendance for MAPSS is 18-23. • Ideas on future presentations included **food/clothing, toilets/sanitation** (article on same above), **"Housing First"** (article on same below), and the **psychology of handling clients**, as many agencies are being inundated with huge numbers of schizophrenics who suddenly need help, triple or quadruple the number of ever before. I will be addressing this psychological issue in the May 20 or June 1 edition of the San Diego Homeless News (whichever becomes the publication date.) I find them all valid except food. • The first of two presentations today was **JFS, Jewish Family Services**, 1-877-537-1818, [www.JFSSD.org](http://www.JFSSD.org). JFS operates 50 programs, some going back to the year 1918, dealing with free auto loans, free home repairs for the elderly, adoption programs, food pantries, refugee resettlement, senior programs, medical and psychiatric case management, transportation to clinics, social programs, computer classes, counseling and advocacy, support groups, domestic abuse services, food assistance, military assistance, parenting and youth services, transitional housing, and teen programs. There is a food give-away in Balboa Park every Thursday from 1-3 at 6th and Olive. In contrast with Catholic or Lutheran Family Services, many programs **PAGE THREE** of JFS are for Jews only. I

asked if it was legal for a Nonprofit Organization to conduct Religious Discrimination against other religions. They said that many things, such as support for Holocaust Victims, were uniquely Jewish. I did not mention that MOST Holocaust Victims were NOT Jewish, of course. I did, however, ask if Palestinians made refugees by Israel would qualify for their Refugee Assistance Program. I did not ask if San Diego Homeless, largely made that way by our predominantly-Jewish banking and real estate systems, would qualify as Economic Refugees in their own country. They did say that their programs would be re-evaluated this Summer, and many things, such as Psychiatric help, may also be open to non-Jews. Discrimination against other religions or cultures is what Hitler's "Master Race" was all about, which is the same thing as proclaiming your group the "Chosen People". • The next topic presenter was the Center For Policy Initiatives, Community Budget Alliance. This program generates proposals for how city money should be spent, based upon ideas, and then citizens vote on approval of new projects. Their website is [onlinecpi.org/campaigns/community-budget-alliance/](http://onlinecpi.org/campaigns/community-budget-alliance/) ♦♦♦♦ **The Ocean Beach Community Town Council met April 25**, hearing many complaints against the homeless in OB, and with no one defending us except newly-appointed Police Captain David Rohowits. No one from the homeless community was at the meeting, nor any spokespersons. <http://obrag.org/?p=83004> ♦♦♦♦ **The Girls Think Tank, a group of lawyers and community leaders, www.GirlsThinkTank.Org, met** Thursday, May 1, with 11 present, including 4 lawyers, 5 community leaders, and 2 very intelligent homeless. 2 of the community leaders were from the Rotary Club, their first time. • The new storage space for the homeless, preventing having their belongings all over downtown, with the risk of theft and the unsightliness that causes, is at 16th and K, across from the Ballpark Apartments, and opens May 3. It is larger and has more bins than the old location. • A fund-raiser Gala Event will be held at the Downtown Library on May 31, tickets click on website, linked above. • The Free Legal Clinic for the poor has been

held at the parking lots where Dreams For Change parks homeless who live in their cars, but also has a permanent weekly place and time at Father Joe's Main Desk, 15th and Imperial Ave., 6 PM, every Thursday except the First Thursday when the main meeting is held at 330 A Street at that time. Open to the public, free pizza. • Toilets were the main topic of discussion. The Downtown Partnership no longer wants to install and maintain the Portland Loos nor other toilets for the homeless and tourists, so they have defaulted? on their contract with the City, and City assigned all these tasks to the Public Works Dept. The problem is that the State of California needs the engineering diagrams of the new toilets to approve them, if done directly by a City, and the City of Portland will not provide same, fearing San Diego will instead build its own copies of their work. Portland engineered a special design to be different from those in Oregon, which meets California codes instead. Clean and Safe took the contract knowing that this permitting process is in effect, and that they are not the City, and so are exempt. Many allegations of possible fraud and breach of contract discussed by the lawyers present. In the meantime, we have now waited 5 years for these "ghost" toilets and have yet to see ground-breaking on them. I mentioned that Kelly Knight was at the MAPSS meeting (above, this heading) recently, and denied that the Downtown Partnership had any hand in reducing and eliminating toilets downtown. Everyone laughed, and said that to be a total lie. It is unanimous that they are the force behind it. This will now take a private agency which contracts with the City, or years of litigation for Breach of Contract and Fraud, to be resolved. • John Kitchin reporting.

**San Diego County-Owned "Nonprofit"**

**Housing Matters SD, regarding  
Supportive Housing:**

Your brochure "Supportive Housing Changes Lives" claims that San Diego County has 9,641

homeless, but there are at least 300,000, and a minimum of 40,000 live on the sidewalk, on rooftops, in drainage ditches, in forests and rural mountains, at any given time. You also say that 59% of homeless suffer from Mental Illness (which you do NOT define), yet studies have proven the figure is about 25%, or one out of 4, the same percentage as in the rest of society. The difference, however, is that the TYPE of mental illnesses the homeless have tend to be the most severe of the diseases, such as schizophrenia. You also list PERT, the Psychiatric Emergency Response Team, and 211 San Diego as resources, and most who have had experiences with those two resources consider them entirely incompetent. Dr. John Kitchin, Ph.D., Psychologist. PS: You should also mention that you are not a "REAL" nonprofit organization, but a "FAKE" one that is actually a unit of government. By the way, I DO support the premise of the brochure, which is that you need a place to live before you can get a job.

**Here is an e-mail I got from a service provider of housing plans that also operates a ministry:**

John, not to sound condescending, but maybe we can give you some aid in your quest for secure housing. We are in touch with a lot of homeless advocates. Excuse me for jumping the gun that is if you are needing our services our facility is right nearby. We were a ministry, and we had our agency in the old motel. We are still using the same facilities but we have changed the way we approach the needs of our population. We used to be somewhat of a stiff-necked religious "Our way or the highway" kind of crew, but through the years we have learned that we need to have compassion towards those who we find need our services. We have worked on our approach and our new Leadership has added secular components to the program to help those who aren't looking for religious training or a church to join. We are still evolving and maybe you might like to come and see what we are doing. Anything is possible in this day and age and maybe you could find a spot here to aid us in our mission. Who knows? We have to keep our options open, but I like where your heart is and I believe since you came from our neighborhood, what have we got to lose? Think about a time that is good for you and my wife and I will pick you up and give you a tour. Then we will take you back to where you want to go you can invite others if you would like. Looking forward to talking to you.

**My Reply:**

Having been a serious victim of many religions many times, I have lately taken the view that anyone who believes in God is a lunatic. I am an author, publisher, psychologist, the Pagan Bishop, and once ran a food pantry in El Cajon. I was a Homeless Advocate 35 years before ever becoming homeless myself. That is why I understand the process more entirely than most. I am seeking neither employment nor housing at this time, having given up on both, and consider all this to be the result of

myself being a major religious victim, too. I do teach seminary on-line, however. All homeless are religion victims, not just me.

I have no dreams, no desires, no beliefs, no aspirations, and look forward to my upcoming suicide. I will be homeless until such time as I can get my clothing, appliances, and furniture out of storage and into a home or apartment where I live alone, and, I would rather die than live in any institution or temporary housing, even if it was free, although it isn't. I once owned Alpine Air Conditioning and Heating, in Alpine, but getting back into that after the George W. Bush Economic Meltdown would cost me \$300,000 and **I refuse to borrow any money. Borrow money and you no longer own your business entirely.** I always earned it, not borrowed it. Now I am too old to do that. It takes a minimum of 20 years, and I am 62. I could be hired for \$200,000 a year or over. Psychologist, engineer, several other possibilities. I do hold a Doctorate in Divinity, and one in Pscyhology, with a Master's in Baking and Brewing, and major Engineering certifications in Radio and Television and Heating and Air Conditioning.

I need to be in Tijuana every evening to feed poor people, and need to spend 4 hours a day on the Internet to update the Poverty Search Engine website, [www.NZ9F.com](http://www.NZ9F.com). **At least 2 hours a day of internet must be from outside of the United States, because many websites and links are blocked by NSA.** Tijuana rents computers for 80 cents an hour. I also publish 2 poverty-related newspapers, as you know, and attend dozens of meetings of government officials and nonprofit organizations. I am the primary spokesperson for the homeless of San Diego County.

My gut reaction as a psychologist is that we have too little in common to proceed, but I am willing to meet with you. **I don't use any dope, by the way, but that is probably a better solution to poverty than Jesus is.**
